- Applicants must be active members of Hope Lutheran Church.
- Faithful attendance at church and Sunday school.
- Applicants must be active in the community.
- Applicants must be pursuing an occupation in a health-care related field.

Donald and Susan Rye Scholarship

- Applicants must have been active members of Hope Lutheran Church.
- Faithful attendance at church and Sunday school.
- Applicants must be active in the community.
- Applicants must be pursuing an occupation in a business-related field.
- Applicant is a sophomore in a post-secondary institution at the time of application and has a grade point average of 2.5 or above.

Hazel and Albert Borson Scholarship

- Applicant is attending a college of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America or other Christian college at the time of application and at the time of the award.
- Applicant is a member of Hope Lutheran Church.
- Applicant is a sophomore in a post-secondary institution at the time of application.
