The Hope Lutheran Church Women (HLCW) met briefly on November 12th in the church after Sunday services. Although it was a small group, a number of items were discussed.

Rose Van Uden gave a report on the meatball supper held on November 5th, and although the final counts were not in, thought it to be a big success. She thanked all those who helped with the preparations, youth and adults who helped during the evening, and all those who donated so generously to the bake sale. A number of suggestions were made including having drivers to deliver take-out meals, changing the menu from carrots to corn, and asking even more younger adults to help with the meal. We all appreciate the leadership that Rose provided for this major project. Funds raised are earmarked for the remodeling of the church kitchen.

The remodeling then became a topic of discussion, with a telephone visit with the Lyon County Environmental Health Manager giving us suggestions as to what we can do in the kitchen. We already have many of the items in our kitchen, such as a dishwasher unit, the coffee making unit, the sink for washing hands, and the food prep sink. Also discussed were the food prep tables and the cupboards in the area. A committee will be formed to make recommendations, get quotes, and then we will see how close we are to having a remodel become reality.

It was also mentioned that a Christmas tree will be used to collect caps, gloves and other outdoor winter apparel for our elementary students. Please be watching for the tree and fill it with outdoor gear that can be used by our students.

A Hope Lutheran Cookbook has also been suggested as a fundraiser for the kitchen, and that will be revisited soon.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned. The group will meet again on Sunday, December 3rd, right after church in the Fellowship Hall . . . So that everyone can enjoy a cup of coffee while we make plans for the future.
