Esther’s Kitchen is a free community to-go meal open to everyone through the non-profit organization, Loaves and Fishes MN. They were founded in 1982 based out of Minneapolis. Their mission is to provide healthy meals to Minnesotans where need is greatest. Through the many years of serving meals, Loaves and Fishes MN served 4,454,745 meals in Minnesota total during the 2020 Pandemic – an increase of 227% from 2019. They are on pace to serve over another 4 million meals in 2022.

Esther’s Kitchen serves to-go meals Monday through Friday, from 5:30 to 6:30 p.m., at Christ United Presbyterian Church in Marshall, MN for anyone in need. Whether it is an individual or a family, they accommodate the number of meals. The walk-around offering on October 23rd will go to Esther’s Kitchen to help provide meals to the community during the holiday season.
